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Student Discipline Policy

1.0 Primary Value

We instill in our students the values of integrity, compassion, tolerance, and justice – enabling them to exhibit self– discipline and positive conduct and to take their place responsibly in society.

2.0 Rationale

Safety, order, and student discipline are fundamental to ensure a safe and secure school environment. At DMES, we promote students' right to feel valued and safe and at the same time, ensure that students conduct themselves at all times in a manner that demonstrates respect for the school, their fellow students and our staff. We teach our students to reflect on errors in judgment and behavior and to impart the understanding of their rights and obligations to behave responsibly. We believe that self-discipline and proper conduct are essential to the success with which a student forms relationships in and out of school, and to later success in life.

3.0 Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance for the regulation of the conduct and discipline of DMES students. It is designed to help and encourage all students to achieve high standards of behavior and to deal fairly and promptly with disciplinary matters in line with the school's rules and regulations.

4.0 Aims

DMES seeks to establish a securely caring community based on mutual trust and respect. Through this policy, we aim to:

- Create a safe and secure learning environment in which all children feel valued and are enabled to fulfill their potential.
- Develop in students a sense of self-discipline and accountability for their own actions, discipline, and learning.
- Promote uniformity, consistency, and fairness in addressing disciplinary issues.
- Encourage a positive relationship with parents/ guardians to support the implementation of the school's policy and associated procedures on student discipline.



5.0 Definitions

- **5.1 Discipline**: The rules and strategies applied in school to manage student behavior and practices used to encourage self-discipline.
- **5.2 Expulsion:** Removal of a student from the school and any other school including the removal of supervision and control of school personnel.
- **5.3 Suspension:** The temporary withdrawal of the privilege of attending school for a specific period of time.

6.0 Discipline Infractions & Consequences

DMES categorizes student misconduct into 6 levels. The disciplinary action shall be taken in accordance with the nature of the students' disciplinary records and the level of offense that is associated with the behavior. All school staff shall ensure that students are given appropriate opportunities to act positively before it is escalated in any disciplinary action.
